1 Basics of computers and devices

- Make hotspot and blue tooth connections
- Connect to available Wi-Fi safely
- Make Internet purchase decisions - Internet access and devices Know about access in the community and in other places
- Be bandwidth and speed conscious Test speed Know how to stream and download
- Use shared community Wi-Fi

4 Online safety

- Mind your digital footprint
- Protect passwords and "friendly" access to your accounts and information
- Use the THINK Principles for being kind to others online

5 Smart mobile technology usage

- Set up iTunes/Google Play accounts to access apps, music and books set up email and other accounts as necessary

- Backup your data and manage personal data between devices to the cloud Manage space limitations
- Trouble shoot and resolve hardware/software issues
- Manage passwords
- Select apps for accessing online services and creating content

Tell others what you found.

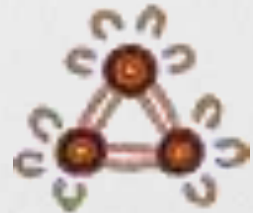
Power tip

Tag people and places you know, including information about yourself as a contributor. Ask people to help you do this.

Power tip

Think about what names people need to find your item.

Look at what is recorded about the items in the database.
